	4.	Utilise design/development tools in accordance with development and documentation standards to create efficient, well documented, reusable code ensuring that ongoing support and future enhancements can be carried out effectively.	
	5.	Debug and test program code, investigate problems and identify solutions to prevent re-occurrence and participate in application testing prior to handover to the relevant team to ensure it meets the user's specification.	
	6.	Conduct coding reviews and propose design changes that will either improve the maintainability, functionality or performance of the solution.	
	7.	Monitor and contribute to professional/expert sources of help, guidance and best practice, e.g. MSDN, Internet discussion groups, to maximise code re-use and ensure that contemporary, industry standard practices and tools are adopted.	
	8.	Assist during the analysis stage of the project as required ensuring that user requirements are understood and met.	
	9.	Maintain and support the applications and infrastructure to meet SLA and performance targets.


